Re: Employee Assistance Program

We are very pleased to announce that effective Monday, May 23, 2016 we will be transitioning to a new Employee Assistance Program (EAP) for the Town of Greenwich and the Board of Education.

The Employee Assistance Program will now be administered by Behavioral Health Consultants (BHC) with headquarters in Hamden and offices in other Connecticut locations. BHC has over 50 licensed therapists within 25 miles of Greenwich as well as a network of over 340 EAP affiliate counselors throughout the State.

BHC has been providing EAP services for over 25 years and works with over two dozen other towns and municipalities including Stamford, New Canaan, Bridgeport, and New Haven, just to name a few.

As a reminder, EAP is a free, confidential assessment and counseling service for employees or your immediate family members. This service helps address a wide range of issues, including but not limited to alcohol or substance abuse, depression, marital or family problems or stress.

Representatives of Behavioral Health Consultants EAP will be here in June and July to talk in greater detail with employees and answer any questions about their services.
